Easy Good Deeds

- Recite the Qu'ran: 10 rewards per letter. (Tirmidhi) This is around 5000 rewards per page!
- Recite Srah al-Ikhlas: Equal to reciting 1/3 of the Qur'an (Bukhari)
- Recite 1000 times in a day:

(a) Equivalent to freeing 10 slaves, (b) 100 rewards given, (c) 100 sins forgiven, (d) Protection from the Shaytaan for the entire day and, (e) No one will receive a greater reward then you except for the one who recites it more. (Bukhari)

- 4. Recite Istighfar 1000 times a day: 1000 rewards given or 1000 sins forgiven. (Muslim)
- Perform two raka'ah salat Al-Duha: 360 sadaqaat. (Muslim)
- 6. After salat Al-Fajr, remain in your place and do zikr until sunrise. Then (approx.15 mins after sunrise) perform two rakah of salat Al-Duha: Complete Hajj and Umrah. (muslim)
- In the morning and the evening recite 100 times:

No one will recive a greater reward than you except for the one who recites it more, (Muslim). The reward will fill the space between the heaven and earth, (Tirmidhi). All of your sins will be forgiven. (Muslim and Tirmidhi)

- All of the doors of Jannah will open for you. (Muslim)
- 9. Do istightar on behalf of all the people of iman: Equivalent to the number of muslims in the world - approimately 2.2 billion! (Tabrani, Jam'al-Jawami) 10. Perform as many Nafl prayers as possible: A continous showering of rewards
 - while you are in salah, (Trimidhi), You will be loved by Allah, (Bukhari)

The Month of Muharram

Muharram is the month with which the Muslims begin their lunar Hijrah Calendar. It is one of the four sanctified months about which the Holy Qur'an says,

"The number of the months according to Allah is Twelve months (mentioned) in the Book of Allah On the day in which He created heavens and the Earth. Among these (twelve months) there are Four sanctified".

These four months, according to the authentic Traditions are the months of Zulga'dah, Zulhijiah, Muharram and Rajab. All the commentators of the Holy Qur'an are unanimous on the point, because the Holy Prophet in his sermon on the occasion of his last Haji has declared:

"One year consists of twelve months, of which Four are sanctified months, three of them are in sequence; Zulqa'dah, Zulhijjah, and the fourth is Rajab".

There are three important points regarding this month:

- 1. Fasting during this Month
- 2. The day of 'Ashurah'
- 3. Misconceptions regarding this Month
