MIC Non-partisan policy

Meadowvale Islamic Centre (MIC) is a registered charitable organization with Government of Canada, Charitable # 861881670RR0001.

MIC encourages the community to participate in the government election and voting process. In order to raise awareness in the community, MIC may allow political candidates and/or organization to share information at MIC events.

However, MIC is a non-partisan organization, and does not endorse any political candidate, or political party. Statements issued by individuals at MIC events favoring any candidate or party does not reflect the opinion of MIC.

Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) has a legal requirement on charitable organizations to be non-partisan, and MIC makes a deliberate effort to meet the requirements. Non-partisan means that a Charity cannot use any of its resources to support or oppose directly or indirectly any political party or candidate for public office.
